

Armonia, Saul and Pilar Cruz

Armonia, now in its 21st year, is the Christ inspired ministry of Saul and Pilar Cruz, and their children, Eidi and Saulito. Many laypersons from around the world have had their hearts captured by this amazing ministry and the Cruz family.

Walking alongside the poor, Armonía's purpose is to transform poverty into an abundant, complete, and dignified life in the name of Christ. It is in specific towns and cities where, together with those in need, Armonía works to bring about real transformation.

In the poorest Burroughs of Mexico City, Armonía has established three community centers where Armonía staff, locals, and international visitors join together to be transformed by the Word of God and by the conversations and community that arise out of life together.

In Oaxaca, Armonía is involved in its AIMS (Armonía Indigenous Mexican Scholars) program, where indigenous (indian) students are given scholarships to live together in Armonía's residence, learn life skills, pursue further education, and experience the transformation that comes from the gospel of Jesus Christ. Armonía's work involves much more, but these are some of the most prominent aspects of the ministry through which God is transforming poverty into life.

Currently, Saulito, a graduate psychologist, continues to work with Armonía in Mexico. Eidi recently graduated with distinction from the London School of Economics (LSE), and is currently working as a research officer at LSE. Saul and Pilar are under constant physical attack as they exhaust themselves amongst the poor in an often unsanitary and unsafe environment. They ask for prayer for God's protection and provision in the coming year.
